EVENT A: HISTORIC CHARLESTON CITY TOUR

Thursday, September 30th (9:30am-3:30pm)

Enjoy a journey back in time as your guide relates interesting anecdotes, while you experience the beauty and charm of one of America's most historic cities. Over 300 years of American history come alive with stories of the *American Revolution* and the “*War between the States*”. At the famous *Battery Sea Wall*, your guide will tell you about the “Harbor of History” and the famous aircraft carrier *USS Yorktown*, at *Patriots Point*. You will then have time on your own for lunch and browsing through the *Market Square* area, well known for its unique shops, boutiques, and restaurants.

EVENT C: CHARLESTON TEA PLANTATION TOUR

Saturday, October 2nd (9:00am-1:00pm)

This morning you will visit The *Charleston Tea Plantation*, located on historic Wadmalaw Island in the heart of the low country of South Carolina. Wadmalaw provides the perfect environment for propagating tea. With its sandy soils, sub-tropical climate and average rainfall of 52 inches per year, Wadmalaw process idyllic conditions for the *Camellia Sinensis* plant. This plant is currently used to produce both black and green teas and exists in over 320 varieties on the 127 acre grounds of the *Charleston Tea Plantation*. Your tour includes a visit to the factory, as you walk down the glass tourway, learn about the history of tea, the harvesting and production. Take a first hand look into the factory and the equipment utilized to produce *American Classic Teas*. Then, board the historic trolley for a narrated tour of America's only Tea Garden. The scenic ride will allow you to see the more than 320 varieties of tea plants in their various stages of growth. As you learn about the history and evolution of American Class Tea, enjoy the breathtaking beauty of these unique, charming and historic grounds. Following the tour, there will be plenty of time to visit the unique gift shop and help yourself to all of the iced American Classic Tea you can drink.
