EVENT A: BEST OF NASHVILLE CITY TOUR

Thursday, September 29th (9:00am-3:00pm)

This is not your typical, routine city tour, but an entertaining look at all the sights that make up Nashville. The morning will be spent touring some of the city's most famous landmarks of the city, including Historic Downtown, *Fort Nashborough*, the State Capitol, the *Parthenon* and *Music Row*. The tour includes some of the stately homes and estates of some of Country Music's legendary performers on *Millionaire's Row*, as well as a stop at the *Bicentennial Mall* and the *Military World War II Memorial*. The tour ends downtown, where you will have plenty of time for lunch on your own, shopping and browsing. You may want to have a cold drink at one of the famous *Honky Tonk's* located on the main street, or spend your time visiting the *Country Music Hall of Fame*, which is also located in the downtown area. EVENT B: THE HERMITAGE-HOME & MUSEUM OF PRESIDENT JACKSON

Friday, September 30th (10:00am-2:30pm)

The *Hermitage Home & Museum* tour provides an authentic glimpse of President Jackson's home life. Faithfully restored, you will feel transported in time to the days of yore. The separate museum is a wonderful interpretation of the times with authentic memorabilia from the Jackson era. The day will begin at the Visitor's Center, where you will watch the short introductory film on Andrew Jackson and *The Hermitage*. While at the center, be sure to view the exhibits on Jackson and *The Hermitage* and explore the gallery's changing exhibits before visiting the *Hermitage Mansion*. The mansion has been meticulously restored to its 1837 appearance. The tour is self guided, with many historical interpreters stationed throughout the mansion. The grounds of the mansion are also self guided and include the gardens, Jackson's tomb, and the slave cabins. Lunch is on your own at the *Garden Gate Café* located in the Visitor's Center.

EVENT C: GRAND OLE OPRY

Friday, September 30th (6:00pm-10:00pm)

This is the show that made Nashville famous! The one, the only, the *Opry*. You never know which celebrities will turn up and perform, but one thing is for certain, it's always a great show, with something for everyone. Music, dancing, and lots of laughs make this variety show a Nashville tradition and a crowd favorite. You'll have great seats, so come see what all the fuss is about! Please be sure to have dinner prior to departing for the show.

Please note: You will be required to walk down 6 steps to your seat for the show. All Opry seats are benches with backs, similar to church pews.

EVENT D: BELLE MEADE PLANTATION TOUR

Saturday, October 1st (9:00am-1:00pm)

Spend the morning at the *Belle Meade Plantation*, a 30 acre historic site just west of Nashville. The centerpiece of the property is the *Belle Meade Mansion*, which was built in 1853. Your day begins with a guided tour of the

1853 Greek Revival Mansion, a century of *Belle Meade Plantation's* history is told through the eyes of the Harding and Jackson Family and the skilled laborers who collectively worked to make the Plantation America's premier Thoroughbred Horse Farm. Following the mansion tour, you will then have time on your own to enjoy the self-guided portion of the tour. There are eight historic buildings on site, including a massive 1800's carriage house and table; you can almost hear the horses clopping on the brick floor of the stable house. Be sure to allow time to visit the winery on site and the extensive gift shop.

Don't miss the chance to have individual portraits and group photos taken prior to the Banquet Dinner. Cocktails will be available from the cash bar at 5:00pm during the photos; dinner will be served at 7:00pm. There is no need to pre-register for the photos.

Join your friends for the Banquet Dinner at the Hotel; dinner will be served at 7:00pm. Entrée choices are Prime Rib or Grilled Chicken. Please make your entrée selection on your reservation form.
